2 Corinthians 5:17 - Therefore, since I am in Christ, I am a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come.

Ephesians 2:10 - For I am his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that I should walk in them.

Romans 8:1 - There is therefore now no condemnation for me because I am in Christ Jesus.

John 1:12 - Because I have received him and believed in his name, I have been given the right to become a child of God.

1 Peter 2:9-10 - But I am part of a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that I may proclaim the excellencies of him who called me out of darkness into his marvellous light. Once I was not part of God's people, but now I am; once I did not receive mercy, but now I have received mercy.

1 Corinthians 3:16 - I am God's temple and God's Spirit dwells in me.

Philippians 3:20 - My citizenship is in heaven, and from it I await a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ,

1 Corinthians 6:17 - I am joined to the Lord have become one spirit with him.

1 Thessalonians 5:5 - For I am a child of light, a child of the day. I am not of the night or of the darkness.

Romans 5:1 - I have been justified by faith, I have peace with God through my Lord Jesus Christ.

2 Peter 1:3-9 - God's divine power has granted to me all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of (Jesus), by which he has granted to us his precious and very great promises, so that through them I may become a partaker of the divine nature, having escaped from the corruption that is in the world because of sinful desire. For this very reason, I will make every effort to supplement my faith with virtue, and virtue with knowledge, and knowledge with self-control, and self-control with steadfastness, and steadfastness with godliness, and godliness with brotherly affection, and brotherly affection with love. For if these qualities are mine and are increasing, they keep me from being ineffective or unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. For whoever lacks these qualities is so nearsighted that he is blind, having forgotten that he was cleansed from his former sins.

2 Corinthians 5:20 - Therefore, I am an ambassador for Christ, God makes his appeal through me.

Ephesians 2:6 - God has raised me up with him and seated me with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus.

Philippians 1:6 - And I (Paul) am sure of this, that he (Jesus) who began a good work in me will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ.

Psalms 139:14 - I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Wonderful are your works; my soul knows it very well.

Romans 6:18 - I have been set free from sin, I have become a slave of righteousness.

Ephesians 2:18 - For through him I have access in one Spirit to the Father.

John 17:17 - I am sanctified in the truth; God's word is truth.

Galatians 2:20 - I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

2 Corinthians 2:15 - For I am the aroma of Christ to God among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing.

John 15:16 - I did not choose Jesus, but Jesus chose me and appointed me that I should go and bear fruit and that my fruit should abide, so that whatever I ask the Father in Jesus' name, he may give it to me.

1 John 5:14-15 - And this is the confidence that I have toward him, that if I ask anything according to his will he hears me. And if I know that he hears me in whatever I ask, I know that I have the requests that I have asked of him.

Acts 1:8 - I received power when the Holy Spirit came upon me, and I will be Jesus' witness in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

Hebrews 4:16 - I will, with confidence, draw near to the throne of grace, that I may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

1 Peter 2:5 - I am like a living stone being built up as part of a spiritual house, to be a holy priesthood, to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.

Colossians 3:12 - I will put on as God's chosen one, holy and beloved, a compassionate heart, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience.

Romans 8:1-39 - There is therefore now no condemnation for me because I am in Christ Jesus. For the law of the Spirit of life has set me free in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and death. For God has done what the law, weakened by the flesh, could not do. By sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh and for sin, he condemned sin in the flesh, in order that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in me, who walk not according to the flesh but according to the Spirit. For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit set their minds on the things of the Spirit. ...

2 Corinthians 1:22 - He has put his seal on me and given me his Spirit in my heart as a guarantee.

1 John 1:9 - If I confess my sins, he is faithful and just to forgive my sins and to cleanse me from all unrighteousness.

1 Corinthians 2:16 - I have the mind of Christ.

John 15:1-5 - Jesus is the true vine, and His Father is the vinedresser. Every branch in Jesus that does not bear fruit the Father takes away, and every branch that does bear fruit the Father prunes, that it may bear more fruit. Already I am clean because of the word that Jesus has spoken to me. I will abide in Jesus, and invite Jesus to abide in me. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can I unless I abide in Jesus. Jesus is the vine; I am a branch. Because I abide in Jesus and Jesus abides in me, I bear much fruit, for apart from Jesus, I can do nothing.

Galatians 4:6 - And because I am his child, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into my heart, crying, "Abba! Father!"

Romans 8:17 - And if children, then heirs - heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, provided I suffer with him in order that I may also be glorified with him.

1 Peter 5:8 - I must be sober-minded and watchful. My adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour.

Jeremiah 29:11 - God knows the plans He has for me, plans for welfare and not for evil, to give me a future and a hope.

James 4:7 - I will submit myself to God, resist the devil, and he will flee from me.

Philippians 4:13 - I can do all things through him who strengthens me.

1 Peter 4:10 - As I have received gifts, I will use these to serve, as a good steward of God's varied grace.

Colossians 3:3 - For I have died, and my life is hidden with Christ in God.

Matthew 5:16 - I will let my light shine before others so that they may see my good works and give glory to my Father who is in heaven.

Romans 8:28 - And I know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose.

1 Peter 3:15 - In my heart I will honor Christ the Lord as holy, always being prepared to make a defense to anyone who asks me for a reason for the hope that is in me; yet do it with gentleness and respect,

John 11:40 - (Jesus says that) if I believe I will see the glory of God

Colossians 1:22 - He has now reconciled in his body of flesh by his death, to present me holy and blameless and above reproach before him,

Ephesians 4:1-32 - I will walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which I have been called, with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. There is one body and one Spirit—just as I was called to the one hope that belongs to my call— one Lord, one faith, one baptism, ...

John 8:12 - Jesus is the light of the world. I who follow him will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life.
